



## FORT BRAGG PEG UPDATE

February 8, 2017

As requested at the PEG BOS ad-hoc committee meeting on January 19, 2017, the following is a brief summary of Fort Bragg's PEG budget and general activities.

### BUDGET:

Fort Bragg has two sources of income with regards to its PEG services:

1. Franchise fees direct from Comcast for providing PEG services within the city limits of Fort Bragg, 50% of which are deposited in the city's general fund for general services
2. Monies from the County, calculated based on a % of franchise fees the county receives, for providing PEG services throughout the coastal areas outside city limits

The following is a chart showing income and expenses for PEG for 2015/2016 and 2016/2017:

\$70,306.90 Not related to PEG television but billed to PEG. Granicus was purchased by a grant for live streaming the City Clerk's 'video minutes of meetings' on to the internet. Just because we encoded video files for the city and played them out on channel 3 did not give Scott the authority to bill City Clerk / IT expenses to the PEG budget.
